

## Parent/Player Athletic Information Sheet

1. The lettering policy of each sport is left up to the head coach of that sport. There are guidelines that are followed:
  - You must be in good standing at the end of the season with the team
  - You must finish the season unless you have a season ending injury which then would leave the lettering policy up to the athletic department and the coach
2. All team members will go to games together in the transportation provided by the school. We would like for the team members to go home from the games together but if there are certain circumstances that a parent needs to take their child they will be allowed to do so. The parent must come in person and tell the coach that he or she is taking the child home. In no circumstances are any players allowed to go home with anyone other than their parent or guardian.
3. Athletics in the Upper School are competitive athletics. Playing time is decided on by the coach based on practice, commitment, ability and other circumstances. Just because you are on a team does not mean you are guaranteed playing time.
4. Each sport has an end of the year banquet in which the coaches present their letters and awards. You must be in good standing with the team at the end of the season to attend the banquet.
5. There is a chain of command that we would like for parents and players to follow. Please first see the coach of your sport and then if necessary please see the Athletic Director and then Administration.
6. We follow the academic standards set by KSHSAA You must pass 5 classes each semester to be eligible. Coaches are instructed to keep up with each player's academic performance which each coach would handle on an individual basis.
7. Student and Parent behavior is expected to be positive at all athletic events. We follow the Sportsmanship Rule set by KSHSAA.
8. All players are expected to be at all practices unless there are certain circumstances that would prevent them from going and it is discussed with the coach
9. Trainer: The school has a certified trainer that is at the school 2 days a week and at certain athletic events.
10. If the team is staying overnight in a hotel, each player is expected to pay for their accommodations unless it is a State Championship event in which the school would pay for their rooms.
11. Uniforms are issued to each player at the beginning of the season. Each player is responsible for the upkeep of their uniform. The player is responsible to return their uniform at the end of the season or they will be charged for their uniform and their grades will be held until this matter is resolved.
